User's feedback on climate change adaptation platforms

The **objective of the workshop** is to increase awareness and seek feedback on the use of the web-based European Climate Adaptation Platform (Climate-ADAPT), hosted by EEA in collaboration with the European Commission, as one of the key elements of the EU Adaptation Strategy. The workshop participants will also hear from several countries their lessons learnt, further developments on national adaptation platforms and their relationships with Climate-ADAPT. The workshop organizers will seek feedback from users on the content and functionalities of these platforms, on the envisaged mid-term developments and on feedback mechanisms from users on their perspectives, needs and capabilities.

The workshop will be informed by an EEA technical report 'Overview of climate change adaptation platforms in Europe' that is planned to be published in advance of the workshop.
